Last year we accommodated 150 High school and College Students. What is ChristPower?

**A week long LifeTeen Retreat that will change your life!** We invite you to answer the call from Christ to serve others, grow spiritually with your teen peers, share your faith and grow closer to Christ through praise and worship. Each teen is eligible for 40 Service Hours upon completion of the week.

- **Check in Sunday, June 14, 2015 early evening...Check out on Saturday, June 20, 2015, after morning mass.** Your attendance during the entire week is required, therefore, leaving for work and recreational activities like sports will not be exceptions to leave the retreat. Absences for medical situations must be submitted and preapproved prior to checking in on Sunday, 6/14.

  - Daily Recreation time at the Renaud Center (and showering)
