Requirements for Admission

Catholic schools are unique expressions of the Church's efforts to achieve the purposes of Catholic education among the young. Academic excellence and a disciplined formation will always be the desired goals of the Catholic school. Central to the school, however, is the understanding of the Catholic tradition and growth in faith. Parents wishing to enroll their children in a Catholic school must understand and agree to the purposes of Catholic schools.

Admission to a Catholic elementary school at any point of entry is contingent upon the family's desire for this special kind of school, where Catholic teaching and moral formation are an integral part of the school. (Non-Catholic families must give the same assurance that they understand the religious requirements and expectations of attending a Catholic school.)

Evidence of any family's desire to be a part of this type of school includes:

- participation in the spiritual and social life of the parish;
- support of the concepts upheld in the Witness Statement;
- agreement to follow the policies and procedures of the school;
- willingness to cooperate with the teachers and administration in the moral, psychological, emotional, spiritual, and academic development of their children.
